Tatya Tope A Patriot Of The Highest Order

One of the most outstanding leaders of India's First War of Independence, Tatya Tope was a patriot of the highest order. He was captured by the British Forces on 07 April, 1859 and after a hurried trial for waging war against the East India Company, he was hanged to death on 18 April 1859 at Shivpuri, Madhya Pradesh.

The Secretary, Mr. Narendra Kumar Sinha and other dignitaries are also present on the occasion.

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
